A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4087 AS INTRODUCED 2-5-91

The bill would amend Public Act 106 of 1909, the act regulating the transmission of electricity, to prohibit the construction of 100,000 volt electrical transmission lines for a period of two years after the bill's effective date. The bill is tie-barred to House Concurrent Resolution No. 25, which would create a special joint committee to study the health dangers of electrical transmission lines over 100,000 volts.
