A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4271 AS INTRODUCED 2-15-91

The bill would amend the Michigan Penal Code to specify that certain sections of the penal code on conspiracy, embezzlement, false pretenses, and larceny would not apply to corresponding violations of the Michigan Employment Security Act. Such violations would be prosecuted only under the employment security act.

The bill would take effect April 1, 1992, providing House Bills 4269, 4270, and 4272, along with three bills that have not yet been introduced, were also enacted. (House Bills 4269, 4270, and 4272 propose related amendments to the Michigan Employment Security Act. The package of legislation includes Senate Bills 33, 34, and 35, which also would amend the employment security act.)
