A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4323 AS INTRODUCED 2-15-91

The Michigan Vehicle Code permits a person to receive a refund for a partial or multiple year vehicle registration if for some reason the registered vehicle no longer will be driven by the registrant (i.e., transfer of title due to a sale, death of a spouse under whose name a vehicle is registered, and the like), or if the person paid more for the registration than he or she should have. The bill would amend the act to permit a person, if not claiming a refund due to revocation, suspension, or denial of his or her driver's license, to instead claim a credit against a subsequent registration in the amount he or she was eligible to receive as a refund. Also, the bill would delete an obsolete provision in the act which refers to a former section of the act that was removed in 1983 by Public Act 165 and replaced by new language (current section 801d(2)).
