**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4402 AND 4499 AS INTRODUCED 2-27-91 & 3-7-91**

House Bill 4402 would amend the School Code (MCL 380.1302) to permit a public school board or the governing board of a nonpublic school to establish academic eligibility requirements for pupils to enroll in driver education courses offered by the public schools. Such standards if adopted would have to be at least as academically demanding as any requirements adopted by the same board for participation in interscholastic athletics. House Bill 4499 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code (MCL 257.811) to take into account the possible imposition of eligibility requirements for enrolling in driver education classes. The bills are tie-barred to one another.
