A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4729 AS INTRODUCED 4-18-91

Public Act 291 of 1967 allows the governing board of a state college or university to enact parking, traffic, and pedestrian ordinances and to provide for the enforcement of these laws by assessing fines. The act currently limits the amount of a fine that can be assessed for violating one of these ordinances to \$25. The bill would amend the act to allow a governing board to establish a civil fine of up to \$100 when an ordinance designated as a civil infraction that prohibited parking in a space reserved for use by handicappers was violated.
