A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4730 AS INTRODUCED 4-18-91

The bill would amend the Michigan Vietnam Veterans Memorial Act, which provides for the financing, construction and placement of a memorial monument dedicated to service men and women who died or are listed as missing in action as a result of the Vietnam conflict, to provide a specific site for the monument's placement. The act now says only that the monument shall be located on state-owned land "in the capital city." The bill would require the monument to be situated on state-owned land that was 1) located in downtown Lansing and bounded by Ottawa Street on the north, Allegan Street on the south, the vacated portion of Sycamore Street between Ottawa and Allegan Streets on the east, and Logan Street on the west, and 2) not more than two acres within the described area that was directly west of the Capitol Dome peak and directly north of the Library of Michigan arch.
