A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4734 AS INTRODUCED 4-22-91

The veterans' trust fund act specifies that for a veteran to qualify for benefits under the act he or she generally must have served for at least 90 days during a specific U.S. military conflict, with certain exceptions. The bill would amend the act to allow an active duty veteran who was a legal resident of the state and who served for at least 30 days in the Persian Gulf military conflict designated by the U.S. President as Operation Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm (anytime on or after August 2, 1990) to qualify for benefits under the act.
