A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4786 INTRODUCED 5-6-91

Under Public Act 33 of 1951, which provides for fire and police protection for townships, villages, and cities with populations of less than 15,000, a municipality may collect fees for emergency services. House Bill 4785 would permit a municipality to collect delinquent emergency fire service fees in the same manner that is provided for the collection of property taxes under the General Property Tax Act. Under the bill, the legislative body of a municipality could provide that fees imposed for emergency fire, police, and ambulance services were a lien upon the property for which the service had been rendered, and that fees that were delinquent for more than three months could be certified to the proper tax assessing officer or agency, and entered upon the next tax roll against the property.
