A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4807 AS INTRODUCED 5-13-91

The bill would amend the Wildlife Conservation Act, which governs the management, taking and possession of game and protected animals, to prohibit the Department of Natural Resources from killing a wild animal considered to be "a nuisance or dangerous" that was captured in an urban area, unless the animal was injured, sick or could not be relocated, at "marginal expense," to an area where it would not be a nuisance or threat to human health, safety or welfare.
