A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4815 AS INTRODUCED 5-14-91

The McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely Lottery Act allows the commissioner of state lottery to suspend or revoke the license of any lottery agent who violates the act or rules promulgated under the act. The bill would amend the act to specify that such license suspensions or revocations would have to follow the contested case provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act.

The bill also would delete the part of the act that allows the commissioner to issue temporary lottery sales agent licenses ("upon conditions as he deems necessary") for up to one year.

MCL 432.23
