GRENADA, PANAMA VETS: PLATES

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4840 and 4841 AS INTRODUCED 5-20-91

The bills would add two new sections to the Michigan Vehicle Code to allow a person who was a member of the armed services during the conflicts in Grenada (House Bill 4840) or Panama (House Bill 4841) to get special license plates from the secretary of state. The special plates would display an appropriate "vignette," or decal, (one for each conflict) preceding the registration numbers and have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the numbers. Either plate would cost \$5 in addition to the regular registration fee, and provision would be made for handicappers to be issued handicapper stickers.
