A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4900 AS INTRODUCED 6-4-91

Public Act 263 of 1974 allows a county with a population of under 600,000 containing a city of 40,000 people or more to levy an accommodations (or hotel-motel) tax of up to five percent of the total accommodation charges. County commissioners can levy the tax by enacting an ordinance.

House Bill 4900 would amend the act to allow, before January 1, 1992, a county with a population under 120,000 containing a city of 35,000 or more to enact an accommodations tax ordinance.
