A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5253 AS INTRODUCED 10-14-91

Public Act 200 of 1969 requires municipal governments to obtain a permit from the Department of Transportation in order to close certain roadways for a parade and allows the department to revoke a permit when an activity fails to meet the act's guidelines and rules for a parade. The bill would amend the act to provide that for a parade permit to be issued, a person could not allow candy or any other food to be thrown by a parade participant who was 1) on a float or other vehicle, 2) walking or 3) riding on a horse or another animal.
