SUNDAY HUNTING ON PRIV. LAND

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5255 AND 5256 AS INTRODUCED 10-14-91

Local Act 6 of 1927 and Local Act 1 of 1937 prohibit Sunday hunting in the counties of Shiawassee and Livingston, respectively. The bills would amend the acts to specify that the prohibition would apply only to public lands, and, thus, would permit Sunday hunting on private lands in the two counties. House Bill 5255 would provide for a referendum to ratify the amendment to Local Act 6 of 1927, to be submitted to the voters of Shiawassee County at the next general election; and House Bill 5256 would do the same for the amendment to the Livingston County local act. If approved by voters of the respective counties, each bill would take effect ten days after certification of the election results.

Note: Article IV, section 29 of the state constitution provides that "no local or special act shall take effect until approved by two-thirds of the members elected to and serving in each house and by a majority of the electors voting thereon in the district affected."
