A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5310 AS INTRODUCED 11-5-91

The Michigan Liquor Control Act generally limits the number of on-premises liquor licenses that can be granted, based on population, but also contains exceptions to the limit. Currently, the act allows for the issuance of 10 special resort licenses each year for 1992 and 1993 to establishments whose business and operation are designed to attract and accommodate tourists to a resort area and whose primary business is not the sale of liquor and another 25 resort licenses to similar establishments with a capital investment of over \$1 million. The bill would increase from 10 to 25 the number of resort licenses in the first category that could be issued each year in 1992 and 1993.
