A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5325 AS INTRODUCED 11-14-91

Public Act 74 of 1968 provides for the registration of snowmobiles and authorizes the Department of Natural Resources to regulate their use in the state. The bill would amend the act to allow the owner of a snowmobile made in 1966 or earlier to register the snowmobile with the department as an antique snowmobile. An application for registration would have to be signed by the snowmobile's owner and be accompanied by a \$20 fee which would be valid without payment of any additional registration fee while the applicant owned the snowmobile. The owner would receive a certificate of registration as well as a registration decal with a distinctive design that differed from the normal registration sticker, indicating that the snowmobile was an antique. A snowmobile registered under the bill could be used only for special occasions such as displays and public entertainment or for necessary testing, maintenance and storage purposes. Unless inconsistent with the bill's provisions, provisions of the act applicable to other snowmobiles would apply to an antique snowmobile registered under the bill.
