ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4363

AN ACT to designate a certain portion of state highway M-59 as the Vietnam veterans memorial highway; and to prescribe the duties of the state transportation department.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Sec. 1. The portion of state highway M-59 between I-96 on the west and M-3 on the east, except for that portion located between the city limits of Pontiac and the city limits of Utica already called the veterans memorial freeway, shall henceforth be known as the Vietnam veterans memorial highway.
- Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall provide for the erection of suitable markers upon the highway indicating the name of the highway.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
