AN ACT to amend Act No. 372 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended "An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms possessed in violation of this act; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act," as amended, being sections 28.421 to 28.434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 3.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Section 1. Act No. 372 of the Public Acts of 1927, as amended, being sections 28.421 to 28.434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 3 to read as follows:
- Sec. 3. A local unit of government may charge an applicant a fee of not more than \$5.00 for the actual and necessary expenses of a license to purchase, carry, or transport a pistol issued under section 2.
