AN ACT to amend section 47 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended "An act to establish and operate a state lottery; to create a bureau of state lottery; to prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe certain powers and duties of other state departments and agencies; to license and regulate sales agents; to create the state lottery fund; to provide for the distribution of lottery revenues and earnings; to provide for an appropriation; and to provide penalties," being section 432.47 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 47 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, being section 432.47 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 47. The auditor general or an independent public accounting firm appointed by the auditor general shall conduct biannual postaudits of all accounts and transactions of the bureau and other special postaudits as the auditor general or legislature deems necessary. The auditor general or his or her agent conducting an audit under this act shall have access and authority to examine all records of the bureau, its distributing agents, and its licensees.
