# ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5203

AN ACT to amend chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled as amended "Of the powers and duties of townships, the election and duties of township officers, and the division of townships," as amended, being sections 41.1a to 41.110c of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 83b.

*The People of the State of Michigan enact:*

Section 1. Chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, as amended, being sections 41.1a to 41.110c of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 83b to read as follows:

Sec. 83b. A police officer of a township or, if authorized by the township board, a constable of a township has the same authority within the township as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
