ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5204

AN ACT to amend Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1947, entitled "An act to authorize the incorporation of charter townships; to provide a municipal charter therefor; and to prescribe the powers and functions thereof," as amended, being sections 42.1 to 42.34 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 21b.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1947, as amended, being sections 42.1 to 42.34 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 21b to read as follows:

Sec. 21b. A police officer of a charter township or, if authorized by the township board, a constable of a charter township has the same authority within the charter township as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
