ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5205

AN ACT to amend chapter VII of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages; to define their powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by villages; to define the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by villages subject thereto; and to validate prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by villages," as amended, being sections 67.1 to 67.64 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 46a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Chapter VII of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, as amended, being sections 67.1 to 67.64 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 46a to read as follows:

CHAPTER VII

Sec. 46a. A police officer of a village has the same authority within the village as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.
