ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5206

AN ACT to amend Act No. 278 of the Public Acts of 1909, entitled as amended "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and for revising and amending their charters; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness; and to validate bonds issued and obligations previously incurred," as amended, being sections 78.1 to 78.28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 22b.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 278 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, being sections 78.1 to 78.28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 22b to read as follows:

Sec. 22b. A police officer of a village has the same authority within the village as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
