ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5207

AN ACT to amend Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, entitled as amended "An act to provide for the incorporation of cities and for revising and amending their charters; to provide for certain powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes by cities, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds or other evidences of indebtedness; to validate actions taken, bonds issued, and obligations heretofore incurred; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts on specific dates," as amended, being sections 117.1 to 117.38 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 34a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, as amended, being sections 117.1 to 117.38 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 34a to read as follows:

Sec. 34a. A police officer of a city or, if authorized by the legislative body, a constable of a city has the same authority within the city as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.
