ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5208

AN ACT to amend chapter XII of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended "An act to provide for the incorporation of cities of the fourth class; to provide for the vacation of the incorporation thereof; to define the powers and duties of such cities and the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by cities; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by cities subject thereto, and to validate such prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by such cities," being sections 92.1 to 92.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Chapter XII of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1895, being sections 92.1 to 92.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4a to read as follows:

CHAPTER XII

Sec. 4a. A police officer of a city or, if authorized by the city council, a constable of a city has the same authority within the city as a deputy sheriff to execute a bench warrant for arrest issued by a court of record or a municipal court.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
