ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5240

AN ACT to designate a certain portion of United States highway 127 as the "Haskell L. Nichols memorial highway"; and to prescribe the duties of the state transportation department.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Sec. 1. The portion of United States highway 127 from the northern border of Jackson county to the intersection of interstate highway 94 shall henceforth be known as the Haskell L. Nichols memorial highway.
- Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall provide for the erection of suitable markers upon the highway indicating the name of the highway.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
