ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5607

AN ACT to amend section 1 of Act No. 117 of the Public Acts of 1970, entitled "An act to permit assessing officers to place tax exempt real and personal property on the tax rolls; and to establish the criteria to determine the status of real and personal property for taxation or tax exempt status," being section 211.191 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 117 of the Public Acts of 1970, being section 211.191 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. If an assessing officer finds that any real property or personal property that for any reason is exempt from taxation under the laws of this state is not being used for the purposes for which the tax exemption is granted, the assessing officer shall place the property on the tax rolls and the property shall be subject to taxation in the same amount and to the same extent as though it had not been exempt from taxation.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
