AN ACT to amend the title of Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of 1982, entitled as amended "An act to create the Michigan justice training commission and the Michigan justice training fund; to provide the powers and duties of certain state agencies; to provide for the distribution and expenditure of funds; to provide for the promulgation of rules; and to repeal this act on a specific date," as amended, being sections 18.421 to 18.430 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. The title of Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of 1982, as amended, being sections 18.421 to 18.430 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

TITLE

An act to create the Michigan justice training commission and the Michigan justice training fund; to provide the powers and duties of certain state agencies; to provide for the distribution and expenditure of funds; and to provide for the promulgation of rules.

Section 2. Section 10 of Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 18.430 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed.
