ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 152

AN ACT to make appropriations for the department of natural resources for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1991; to provide for certain work projects; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of natural resources to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1991, from the following funds:

Sec. 201. In accordance with provisions of section 30 of article II of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in this appropriation act is \$27,229,700.00 and the state appropriation to be paid to local units of government in section 101 is \$19,200,000.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

Sec. 203. For all projects and grant programs funded under this act, the commission of natural resources or the department of natural resources shall notify each legislator whose district is to receive a grant 7 days before the grant is announced.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE

Sec. 301. The appropriation in section 101 for environmental protection bond site reclamation loan and grant program shall not be encumbered or expended until both of the following conditions have been met:

(a) Rules are promulgated under section 8(a)(i) of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 299.678 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

(b) The department has reported to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on natural resources those projects that have been approved for expenditure by the commission of natural resources under this program.

Sec. 302. The unexpended portion of the appropriation in section 101 for environmental protection bond alternative municipal water supply projects, surface cleanup projects, site investigations, final cleanup projects, operation and maintenance, and the site reclamation loan and grant program shall be considered work projects and shall not lapse to the environmental protection bond fund but continue to be available for the purposes appropriated.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Sec. 401. The appropriation for landfill and dump closures in section 101 is to be provided in order of priority as listed.

Sec. 402. The unexpended portion of the appropriation in section 101 for waste management projects shall be considered a work project and shall not lapse to the environmental protection bond fund but shall continue to be available for the purpose for which it was appropriated.

Sec. 501. This act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill No. 153 of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
