ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 163

AN ACT to amend section 502b of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled "An act to revise, consolidate, codify and add to the statutes relating to crimes; to define crimes and prescribe the penalties therefor; to provide for the competency of evidence at the trial of persons accused of crime; to provide immunity from prosecution for certain witnesses appearing at such trials; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with or contravening any of the provisions of this act," being section 750.502b of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 502b of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, being section 750.502b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 502b. A person who knowingly sells or attempts to sell to any person in this state, for use in atmospheric pressure wick-feed illuminating apparatus or atmospheric pressure wick-feed heating stoves or in gravity-feed cook stoves, any kerosene, whether manufactured in this state or not, that has a flash point of less than 100 degrees Fahrenheit as determined by an appropriate closed cup tester method specified in the American standards of testing materials standard for kerosene, is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by a fine of not more than \$300.00, or both.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
