A bill to provide for the direct deposit of state warrants into financial institutions; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- 3 (b) "Financial institution" means a state or nationally
- 4 chartered bank, a state or federally chartered savings and loan
- 5 association or savings bank, a state or federally chartered
- 6 credit union, or an affiliate or subsidiary thereof.
- 7 (c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, association,
- 8 corporation, or any other legal entity.
- 9 (d) "Warrant" means a written instrument that is issued by
- 10 the state and that authorizes the payment of money.

- 1 Sec. 2. The department shall establish a distribution
- 2 system by which a recipient of a state warrant may direct that
- 3 the entire amount of the warrant, or any portion thereof, be
- 4 directly deposited by the department into 1 or more accounts
- 5 maintained by the recipient with a financial institution.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) The department shall promulgate rules to imple-
- 7 ment this act pursuant to the administrative procedures act of
- 8 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, being sections
- 9 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 10 (2) The promulgated rules shall include, but are not limited

- (a) A reimbursement schedule for the reasonable fees and
