

# HOUSE BILL No. 4087

February 5, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Oxender and Nye and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

**A bill to amend Act No. 106 of the Public Acts of 1909,  
entitled as amended**

"An act to regulate the transmission of electricity through the public highways, streets and places of this state, where the source of supply and place of use are in the same or different counties; to regulate the charges to be made for electricity so transmitted; to regulate the rules and conditions of service under which said electricity shall be furnished and to confer upon the Michigan public utilities commission certain powers and duties in regard thereto,"

as amended, being sections 460.551 to 460.559 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Section 1. Act No. 106 of the Public Acts of 1909, as  
2 amended, being sections 460.551 to 460.559 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4a to read as  
4 follows:

1        SEC. 4A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A  
2 PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION REGULATED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT  
3 CONSTRUCT ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES WITH A VOLTAGE OF 100,000  
4 VOLTS OR MORE FOR A PERIOD OF 2 YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF  
5 THIS SECTION.

6        Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
7 House Concurrent Resolution No. 25 (R 212'91) of the 86th  
8 Legislature is adopted by the Senate and House of  
9 Representatives.
