

# HOUSE BILL No. 4123

February 7, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Randall and Power and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend sections 4a, 7a, and 15 of Act No. 290 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"Boiler act of 1965,"

section 4a as amended by Act No. 277 of the Public Acts of 1986 and section 7a as amended by Act No. 176 of the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 408.754a, 408.757a, and 408.765 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Sections 4a, 7a, and 15 of Act No. 290 of the  
2 Public Acts of 1965, section 4a as amended by Act No. 277 of the  
3 Public Acts of 1986 and section 7a as amended by Act No. 176 of  
4 the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 408.754a, 408.757a, and  
5 408.765 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as  
6 follows:

1       Sec. 4a. (1) ~~The board, with the advice of the director,~~  
 2 ~~shall promulgate rules pursuant to The administrative procedures~~  
 3 ~~act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended,~~  
 4 ~~being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, to~~  
 5 ~~establish the fee schedules for licenses, permits, certificates,~~  
 6 ~~and inspections.~~ The fees SET FORTH IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3)  
 7 shall reflect the actual costs and expenses for the department of  
 8 labor in issuing licenses, permits, and certificates and in con-  
 9 ducting inspections.

10       (2) FEES FOR LICENSES, PERMITS, CERTIFICATES, AND INSPEC-  
 11 TIONS SHALL BE PAID ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

12 (3) UPON REQUEST, THE BOILER DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
 13 LABOR SHALL CONDUCT SPECIAL INSPECTIONS NOT COVERED IN THE FEE  
 14 SCHEDULE IN SUBSECTION (2). THE CHARGE FOR THIS SERVICE IS  
 15 \$50.00 FOR EACH HOUR, PLUS THE COST OF LODGING, MEALS, TRANSPOR-  
 16 TATION, AND OTHER RELATED COSTS INCURRED IN CONDUCTING THE SPE-  
 17 CIAL INSPECTION.

18 (4) A FEE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION OR SECTIONS 7A AND 15  
 19 SHALL BE PAID BY CASH, MONEY ORDER, OR CHECK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
 20 LABOR.

21 (5) ~~(2)~~ To accomplish the objectives of this section and  
 22 this act, a state boiler inspection fund is created IN THE  
 23 DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. The state treasurer shall be the custo-  
 24 dian of the fund and may invest the surplus of the fund in  
 25 investments as in the state treasurer's judgment are in the best  
 26 interest of the fund. Earnings from those investments shall be  
 27 credited to the fund. The state treasurer shall notify the

1 director and the legislature of interest credited and the balance  
2 of the fund as of September 30 of each year. The director shall  
3 supervise and administer the fund. Fees received by the depart-  
4 ment of labor and money collected under this act shall be depos-  
5 ited in the state boiler inspection fund and shall be appropri-  
6 ated by the legislature for the operations of the boiler division  
7 and indirect overhead expenses in the department of labor. Funds  
8 that are unexpended at the end of each fiscal year shall be  
9 returned to the state boiler inspection fund.

10       Sec. 7a. (1) Antique traction steam boilers shall comply  
11 with the rules promulgated by the board and shall be inspected  
12 once every 3 years, ~~-. An owner of an antique traction steam~~  
13 ~~boiler-~~ EXCEPT THAT ITS OWNER may request an inspection more  
14 often. ~~than every 3 years.~~ Antique traction steam boilers used  
15 for commercial purposes shall be inspected annually. If the  
16 inspection is made by a deputy inspector, the fee ~~shall be~~ IS  
17 \$25.00. Fees established in this section ~~shall~~ ARE not ~~be~~  
18 subject to change by rule. ~~A~~ THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR SHALL  
19 ISSUE A certificate of inspection ~~shall be issued by the depart-~~  
20 ~~ment of labor~~ upon compliance with the applicable rules.

21       (2) This act ~~shall~~ DOES not apply to miniature steam or  
22 marine engines used as a hobby.

23       Sec. 15. If a license is lost or destroyed, ~~a new license~~  
24 ~~shall,~~ upon application and payment of a fee of \$5.00, ~~be~~  
25 ~~issued-~~ THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR SHALL ISSUE A NEW LICENSE in its  
26 place without another examination.
