## **HOUSE BILL No. 4184**

February 7, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Alley and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1975, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the titling, licensure, and regulation of off-road recreation vehicles; to create certain funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain officers, agencies, and institutions; and to provide penalties,"

as amended by Act No. 71 of the Public Acts of 1990, being section 257.1601 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1975, as amended by Act No. 71 of the Public Acts of 1990, being
- 3 section 257.1601 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "ATV" means a 3- or 4-wheeled vehicle designed for
- 7 off-road use that has low pressure tires, has a seat designed to

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- 1 be straddled by the rider, and is powered by a 50cc to 500cc
- 2 gasoline engine or an engine of comparable size using other
- 3 fuels.
- 4 (b) "Code" means the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of
- 5 the Public Acts of 1949, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the
- 6 Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 7 (c) "Commission" means the commission of <del>natural resources</del>
- 8 CONSERVATION AND RECREATION.
- 9 (d) "Dealer" means a person engaged in the sale, lease, or
- 10 rental of an ORV as a regular business.
- (e) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
- (f) "Designated" means posted open for ORV use with appro-
- 13 priate signs by the department.
- (g) "Forest road" means a hard surfaced road, gravel or dirt
- 15 road, fire lane, abandoned railroad right-of-way, logging road,
- 16 or other way capable of travel by a 4-wheel vehicle, except an
- 17 interstate, state, or county highway.
- (h) "Forest trail" means a designated path or way capable of
- 19 travel only by a vehicle less than 50 inches in width.
- (i) "Highway" means the entire width between the boundary
- 21 lines of a way publicly maintained when any part of the way is
- 22 open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.
- 23 (j) "Manufacturer" means a person, partnership, corporation,
- 24 or association engaged in the production and manufacture of ORVs
- 25 as a regular business.
- (k) "Operate" means to ride in or on, and be in actual
- 27 physical control of, the operation of an ORV.

- 1 (1) "Operator" means a person who operates, or is in actual2 physical control of the operation of an ORV.
- 3 (m) "ORV" or "vehicle" means a motor driven off-road recre-
- 4 ation vehicle capable of cross-country travel without benefit of
- 5 a road or trail, on or immediately over land, snow, ice, marsh,
- 6 swampland, or other natural terrain. It includes, but is not
- 7 limited to a multitrack or multiwheel drive vehicle, an ATV, a
- 8 motorcycle or related 2-wheel, 3-wheel, or 4-wheel vehicle, an
- 9 amphibious machine, a ground effect air cushion vehicle, or other
- 10 means of transportation deriving motive power from a source other
- 11 than muscle or wind. "ORV" or "vehicle" does not include a reg-
- 12 istered snowmobile, a farm vehicle being used for farming, a
- 13 vehicle used for military, fire, emergency, or law enforcement
- 14 purposes, a construction or logging vehicle used in performance
- 15 of its common function, or a registered aircraft.
- 16 (n) "Owner" means any of the following:
- 17 (i) A vendee or lessee of an ORV which is the subject of an
- 18 agreement for the conditional sale or lease of the ORV, with the
- 19 right of purchase upon performance of the conditions stated in
- 20 the agreement, and with an immediate right of possession vested
- 21 in the conditional vendee or lessee.
- 22 (ii) A person renting an ORV, or having the exclusive use of
- 23 an ORV, for more than 30 days.
- 24 (iii) A person who holds legal ownership of an ORV.
- (o) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 26 the state or any of its agencies or subdivisions, or a body of
- 27 persons whether incorporated or not.

- 1 (p) "Public agency" means the department or a local unit of 2 government.
- 3 (q) "Roadway" means that portion of a highway improved, des-
- 4 ignated, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel. If a highway
- 5 includes 2 or more separate roadways, the term roadway refers to
- 6 a roadway separately, but not to all roadways collectively.
- 7 (r) "Safety education fund" means the safety education fund
- 8 created pursuant to section 6b.
- 9 (s) "Safety chief instructor" means a person who has been
- 10 certified by a nationally recognized ATV and ORV organization to
- 11 certify instructors and to do on-sight evaluations of
- 12 instructors.
- (t) "Trail improvement fund" means the ORV trail improvement
- 14 fund created pursuant to section 6a.
- (u) "Visual supervision" means the direct observation of the
- 16 operator with the unaided or normally corrected eye, where the
- 17 observer is able to come to the immediate aid of the operator.
- 18 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 19 all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted
- 20 into law:
