

HOUSE BILL No. 4188

February 7, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Alley and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 173 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled as amended

"An act to protect and preserve, and to regulate the taking of, aboriginal records and antiquities within this state; to preserve abandoned property of historical or recreational value on the bottomlands of the Great Lakes and regulate the salvage of abandoned property of historical or recreational value; to designate and regulate Great Lakes bottomland preserves; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; to create a fund; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

as amended by Act No. 184 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 299.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 173 of the Public Acts of
2 1929, as amended by Act No. 184 of the Public Acts of 1980, being
3 section 299.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

1 Sec. 2. A deed, as provided by this act, given by this
 2 state, except state tax deeds for the conveyance of any land
 3 owned by the state, shall contain a clause reserving to this
 4 state a property right in aboriginal antiquities including
 5 mounds, earthworks, forts, burial and village sites, mines, or
 6 other relics and also reserving the right to explore and excavate
 7 for the aboriginal antiquity by and through this state's autho-
 8 rized agent and employee. This section ~~shall apply~~ APPLIES
 9 only to the sale of tax reverted land. The commission of
 10 ~~natural resources~~ CONSERVATION AND RECREATION with the approval
 11 of the secretary of state may waive this reservation when convey-
 12 ing platted property and when making conveyances under Act
 13 No. 193 of the Public Acts of 1911, as amended, being sections
 14 322.481 to ~~322.484~~ 322.485 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

15 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
 16 all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted
