

# HOUSE BILL No. 4190

February 7, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Alley and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled

"An act to provide authorization for the state to cooperate with the federal government in the selection, development, and maintenance of wildlife restoration and management projects and areas, and to restrict the use of hunting license fees as provided in the act of congress, entitled "An act to provide that the United States shall aid the states in wildlife restoration projects, and for other purposes," approved September 2, 1937, (Public No. 415, 75th Congress),"

being section 299.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of  
2 1939, being section 299.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 1. The ~~conservation commission is hereby authorized,~~  
5 ~~empowered, and directed to~~ COMMISSION OF CONSERVATION AND  
6 RECREATION SHALL perform such acts as may be necessary ~~to~~ FOR

1 the conduct and establishment of wildlife restoration,  
 2 management, and research projects and areas in cooperation with  
 3 the federal government as defined in ~~the act of congress, enti-~~  
 4 ~~tled "An act to provide that the United States shall aid the~~  
 5 ~~states in wildlife restoration projects, and for other purposes,"~~  
 6 ~~approved September 2, 1937, (Public No. 415, 75th Congress)~~  
 7 CHAPTER 899, 50 STAT. 917, 16 U.S.C. 669 TO 669b AND 669c TO  
 8 669i, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FEDERAL AID IN WILDLIFE RESTORATION  
 9 ACT, and with rules and regulations promulgated by the secretary  
 10 of agriculture ~~thereunder~~ UNDER THAT ACT; and in compliance  
 11 with ~~said~~ THAT act no funds accruing to the state ~~of Michigan~~  
 12 from license fees paid by hunters shall be used for any purpose  
 13 other than game and fish activities under the administration of  
 14 the ~~conservation~~ department OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

15 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
 16 all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted
