THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 107 of chapter 14 of the Revised
- 2 Statutes of 1846, being section 55.107 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 107. (1) The governor SECRETARY OF STATE may appoint
- 5 1 or more persons notaries public in each county of this state,
- 6 who shall hold their offices respectively for 4 years from the
- 7 date of their appointment, unless sooner removed by the
- 8 -qovernor SECRETARY OF STATE. -No- A person shall NOT be
- 9 eligible to receive such an appointment unless he or she shall

- 2 county of which he or she desires to be appointed notary public,

- 6 of each county, stating the age of the applicant, which applica-
