

HOUSE BILL No. 4250

February 13, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Jondahl, Kosteva, Hertel, Murphy, Anthony, DeBeaussiaert, Gubow, Saunders, DeMars, Pitoniak, Johnson, Perry Bullard and Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

as amended, being sections 600.101 to 600.9947 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1348a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, as
2 amended, being sections 600.101 to 600.9947 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1348a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1348A. AN EMPLOYER OR AN EMPLOYER'S AGENT SHALL NOT
6 PENALIZE AN EMPLOYEE WHO SERVES ON A JURY BY REQUIRING THAT
7 EMPLOYEE TO USE ANNUAL OR VACATION LEAVE, 1 OR MORE PERSONAL
8 DAYS, OR ANY OTHER FORM OF PERSONAL LEAVE TIME FOR THE TIME THAT
9 THE EMPLOYEE WAS ABSENT FROM WORK DUE TO JURY DUTY. AN EMPLOYER

1 OR AN EMPLOYER'S AGENT WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
2 MISDEMEANOR AND MAY ALSO BE PUNISHED FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT.
