- 4 SEC. 147C. (1) A PERSON IS GUILTY OF HARASSMENT OF MILITARY
- 5 PERSONNEL IF THE PERSON WITH SPECIFIC INTENT TO HARASS ANOTHER
- 6 PERSON BECAUSE OF THAT PERSON'S MEMBERSHIP IN OR AFFILIATION WITH
- 7 THE ARMED FORCES OF THIS STATE OR THE UNITED STATES DOES ANY OF
- 8 THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 (A) CAUSES PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH ANOTHER PERSON.
- 2 (B) DAMAGES, DESTROYS, OR DEFACES ANY REAL OR PERSONAL

- 23 IS INELIGIBLE FOR ANY STATE PROGRAM OF FINANCIAL AID FOR HIGHER
- 24 EDUCATION.
- 25 (5) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT PROSECUTION FOR ANY OTHER
- 26 OFFENSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
