

# HOUSE BILL No. 4299

February 15, 1991, Introduced by Reps. DeMars, Hoffman, Bartnik, Owen, Rocca, Hertel and Muxlow and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"An act to provide free tuition for North American Indians in public state community or public junior colleges, public colleges, or public universities,"

being section 390.1251 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of  
2 1976, being section 390.1251 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1. A public state community or public junior college,  
5 public college, or public university shall waive tuition for any  
6 North American Indian who qualifies for admission as a full-time,  
7 part-time, or summer school student, ~~and~~ is a legal resident of  
8 the state for not less than 12 consecutive months. AN INDIVIDUAL  
9 WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF HARASSMENT OF MILITARY PERSONNEL IN

1 VIOLATION OF SECTION 147C OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, ACT NO. 328  
2 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931, BEING SECTION 750.147C OF THE  
3 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A TUITION WAIVER  
4 UNDER THIS ACT.

5       Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
6 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 4294 (request  
7 no. 02319'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
