

# HOUSE BILL No. 4377

February 26, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Pitoniak, Kilpatrick, Hoffman, Walberg, DeMars, Nye, McNutt, Barns, Knight and Robertson and referred to the Committee on House Oversight.

A bill to repeal Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of probation recovery camps; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state prison commission with respect thereto; to designate persons eligible for entrance in said camps, and to declare the effect of this act,"

being sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935, being  
2 sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 repealed.

4       Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate  
5 Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 4370 (request no. 02155'91) of  
6 the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
