THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

(1) The -city council LEGISLATIVE BODY of a city 2 -, whether organized under the general law or special charter, or 3 the president and board of trustees of a OR village may estab-4 lish and maintain garbage systems or plants for the collection, 5 and SEPARATION, COMPOSTING, RECYCLING, OR disposal of garbage 6 in the city or village, and may levy a tax not to exceed 3 mills 7 on the dollar on all taxable property in the city or village 8 according to the valuation of the -same, as PROPERTY made for 9 the purpose of state and county taxation by the last assessment 10 in the city or village.
for these purposes. THE LEGISLATIVE 11 BODY OF A CITY OR VILLAGE MAY LEVY UP TO AN ADDITIONAL 3 MILLS 12 FOR THESE PURPOSES IF APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE QUALIFIED 13 ELECTORS OF THE CITY OR VILLAGE VOTING ON THE QUESTION. The 14 annual garbage tax shall be in addition to the amount authorized 15 to be levied for general purposes by the general law or special 16 charter under which the city or village is incorporated. All 17 cities or villages may, for the construction of a garbage 18 COLLECTION, SEPARATION, COMPOSTING, RECYCLING, OR disposal plant 19 or system, issue bonds in a sum not to exceed 3 mills, OR 6 20 MILLS, IF ADDITIONAL MILLAGE IS APPROVED BY THE ELECTORS AS PRO-21 VIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, on the dollar on all taxable property 22 in the city or village according to the valuation of the same, 23 as PROPERTY made for the purpose of state and county taxation by 24 the last assessment in the city or village, and may make the 25 bonds run for a period of not to exceed 5 years and to bear 26 interest at a rate not to exceed the maximum rate permitted by 27 THE MUNICIPAL FINANCE ACT, Act No. 202 of the Public Acts of

- 3 (2) As used in this act, "garbage" means any putrescible and
- 4 nonputrescible solid wastes, except body wastes, and includes
- 5 -ashes ASH, incinerator ash, incinerator residue, street clean-
- 6 ings, solid market wastes, solid industrial wastes, and also rub-
- 7 bish including such items as paper, cardboard, tin cans, yard
- 8 clippings, wood, glass, bedding, crockery, and litter of any
- 9 kind.
