

# HOUSE BILL No. 4511

March 11, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bodem, Alley, Baade, McBryde and Brackenridge and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend the title of Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended

"An act to register and regulate snowmobiles; to provide for education and training programs; to provide for trails, areas, and facilities; to create a recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund; to provide for expenditure of appropriations; and to prescribe penalties,"

as amended, being sections 257.1501 to 257.1518 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 4f.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. The title of Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of  
2 1968, as amended, being sections 257.1501 to 257.1518 of the  
3 Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and section 4f is added to  
4 read as follows:

1 TITLE

2 An act to register and regulate snowmobiles; TO PROVIDE  
3 POWERS AND DUTIES FOR CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS; to provide for educa-  
4 tion and training programs; to provide for trails, areas, and  
5 facilities; to create a recreational snowmobile trail improvement  
6 fund; to provide for expenditure of appropriations; and to pre-  
7 scribe penalties.

8 SEC. 4F. (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL  
9 CREATE AND MAINTAIN A SET OF SNOWMOBILE TRAIL MAPS, 1 OF WHICH  
10 SHALL BE FOR THE UPPER PENINSULA AND 1 OF WHICH SHALL BE FOR THE  
11 LOWER PENINSULA.

12 (2) THE MAPS SHALL BE COLOR CODED WITH STATE TRAILS IN 1  
13 COLOR AND TRAILS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN A DIFFERENT COLOR.

14 (3) EACH MAP SHALL INDICATE THE LOCATION ALONG EACH TRAIL OF  
15 PLACES WHERE FOOD AND BEVERAGES MAY BE OBTAINED, THE DISTANCES  
16 BETWEEN THOSE LOCATIONS, AND ANY LOCATIONS WHERE TRAILS INTERSECT  
17 WITH STATE TRUNKLINE HIGHWAYS, COUNTY ROADS, OR CITY AND VILLAGE  
18 STREETS.

19 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL FURNISH APPRO-  
20 PRIATE SIGNS ON STATE TRAILS. THE OWNERS OF LANDS ALONG PRIVATE  
21 TRAILS MAY POST APPROPRIATE SIGNS ON THOSE TRAILS.
