- 10 EXISTENCE OF COVERAGE, THE NAME OF THE INSURER, THE EXTENT OF

- 1 COVERAGE, AND THE DEDUCTIBLE AMOUNT, BEFORE GIVING THE WRITTEN 2 ESTIMATE.
- 3 (2) A PERSON IN THE EMPLOY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR facil-
- 4 ity shall not charge for work done or parts supplied in excess of
- 5 the -estimated price- WRITTEN ESTIMATE REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (1)
- 6 or in excess of the limit stated by the customer in the waiver
- 7 provided for in subsection $\frac{(3)}{(5)}$ (5) without the knowing written
- 8 or oral consent of the customer which shall be obtained at some

- 11 parts for the repair of a motor vehicle without receiving a writ-
- 12 ten estimate and voluntarily agrees to pay all reasonable costs
- 13 of repair up to an amount stated by the customer, a MOTOR VEHICLE
- 14 repair facility may obtain from the customer a waiver of his OR
- 15 HER right to receive a prior estimate of repair costs. The
- 16 waiver shall be in 14 point or larger bold capital type face and
- 17 executed with 1 copy to the customer requesting the repairs and
- 18 shall read as follows:
- 19 "I, , voluntarily request ____ to provide services
- 20 or parts in the repair of the below described motor vehicle without
- 21 receiving an estimate of repair costs. By signing this form, I
- 22 understand that I will give up my right to:
- Receive a written estimate of the cost for repairs;
- 24 2. Approve in advance any repairs or costs with a total cost
- 25 under \$ ___ ; and
