

# HOUSE BILL No. 4560

March 13, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to provide for certain duties of the secretary of state; and to prescribe certain penalties for violations,"

being section 28.291 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of  
2 1972, being section 28.291 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1. (1) A person who is a resident of this state may  
5 apply to the department of state for an official state personal  
6 identification card. Upon application, the applicant shall  
7 supply a birth certificate attesting to his OR HER age or other

1 sufficient documents or identification as the secretary of state  
2 may require.

3 (2) THE APPLICATION FOR A STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD  
4 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL CONTAIN ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

5 (A) THE NAME OF THE APPLICANT.

6 (B) THE ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDING THE STREET AND  
7 NUMBER OR RURAL ROUTE AND BOX NUMBER, IF ANY, THE CITY OR TOWN-  
8 SHIP AND COUNTY OF RESIDENCY, AND, IF KNOWN, THE SCHOOL  
9 DISTRICT.

10 (C) THE DATE OF BIRTH OF THE APPLICANT.

11 (D) THE BIRTHPLACE OF THE APPLICANT.

12 (E) THE INFORMATION PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3).

13 (F) THE CITIZENSHIP OF THE APPLICANT.

14 (G) IF THE APPLICANT CHOOSES TO REGISTER TO VOTE, A SPACE  
15 FOR THE APPLICANT TO DECLARE A PARTY PREFERENCE OR THAT THE  
16 APPLICANT HAS NO PARTY PREFERENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING IN A  
17 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION.

18 (H) THE SIGNATURE AND CERTIFICATION OF THE APPLICANT TO THE  
19 TRUTH OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE APPLICATION.

20 (3) THE APPLICANT MAY INDICATE ON THE APPLICATION 1 OF THE  
21 FOLLOWING:

22 (A) THAT THE APPLICANT CHOOSES NOT TO REGISTER TO VOTE.

23 (B) THAT THE APPLICANT, FOR PURPOSES OF VOTER REGISTRATION,  
24 CHOOSES A DIFFERENT ADDRESS THAN THE ADDRESS INDICATED ON THE  
25 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD APPLICATION, IF HE OR SHE MAINTAINS  
26 MORE THAN 1 RESIDENCE. THE APPLICANT SHALL ALSO PLACE THE

1 DIFFERENT ADDRESS FOR VOTER REGISTRATION PURPOSES ON THE  
2 APPLICATION.

3 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
4 all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted  
5 into law:
