

# HOUSE BILL No. 4600

March 20, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Jacobetti and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the state institutions of higher education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; and to provide for the expenditures of the appropriations.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the state institutions of  
2 higher education and certain state purposes related to education, and  
3 subject to the conditions set forth in this act, from the general fund of  
4 the state, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992, the sum of  
5 \$                   or as much thereof as may be necessary for the several  
6 purposes and in the following respective amounts:

8       Sec. 201. (1) The sums appropriated in this act shall be paid out  
9 of the state treasury and shall be distributed by the state treasurer to  
10 the respective institutions in 12 monthly installments.

1       (2) Each of the amounts appropriated shall be used solely for the  
2 respective purposes stated in this act, except as otherwise provided by  
3 law. A college or university shall not pay an employer's contribution to  
4 more than 1 retirement fund providing benefits for any employee.

5       (3) It is a condition of this appropriation that each college and  
6 university submit the reports required under section 3 at the time as  
7 required by the state budget director and the legislature. The state  
8 budget director shall withhold the remaining allotments and the state  
9 treasurer shall cease and desist from the payment of funds to any college  
10 or university until these reports are submitted.

11       (4) Money received by the state from the federal government or pri-  
12 vate sources for the use of any college or university are appropriated  
13 for the purpose for which provided. The acceptance and use of federal or  
14 private funds does not place an obligation upon the legislature to con-  
15 tinue the purposes for which the funds are made available.

16       Sec. 202. (1) As a part of their budget request, all colleges and  
17 universities shall furnish the program and financial information required  
18 by, and in a manner prescribed by, the state budget director.

19       (2) Pursuant to section 4 of article VIII of the state constitution  
20 of 1963, all state institutions of higher education shall furnish an  
21 annual accounting of all income and expenditures to the legislature and  
22 the state budget director.
