

HOUSE BILL No. 4640

March 21, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Middaugh and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 207 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
being section 750.207 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to
repeal certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 207 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of
2 1931, being section 750.207 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 207. (1) ~~Placing explosives with intent to destroy~~
5 ~~and causing injury to any person Any~~ A person who places AN
6 EXPLOSIVE SUBSTANCE in, upon, under, against, or near ~~to~~ any

8 Section 2. Section 328 of the Michigan penal code, Act
9 No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, being section 750.328 of the
10 Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed.

11 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

13 no. 01162'91 a) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
