- 5 SEC. 2292. ALL CLAIM FORMS PROVIDED TO AN INSURED BY AN
- 6 INSURER SHALL CONTAIN A STATEMENT THAT CLEARLY STATES IN SUB-
- 7 STANCE THE FOLLOWING: "A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY, AND WITH INTENT
- 8 TO INJURE, DEFRAUD, OR DECEIVE AN INSURER, FILES A STATEMENT OF

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- 1 CLAIM CONTAINING FALSE, INCOMPLETE, OR MISLEADING INFORMATION IS
- 2 GUILTY OF A FELONY".

- 5 no. 01292'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
