

HOUSE BILL No. 4674

April 16, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Bartnik, Alley, DeMars, Nye, Harder, Hoekman, Martin, Jaye, Middaugh, Bodem, Dalman, Hoffman, Dobb and Middleton and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend the title and sections 1104 and 2201 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "Public health code," being sections 333.1104 and 333.2201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title and sections 1104 and 2201 of Act
2 No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.1104 and
3 333.2201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as
4 follows:

6 An act to protect and promote the public health; to codify,
7 revise, consolidate, classify, and add to the laws relating to
8 public health; to provide for the prevention and control of
9 diseases and disabilities; to provide for the classification,

2 personal, environmental, and other health services and activi-
3 ties; to create or continue, and prescribe the powers and duties
4 of, departments, boards, commissions, councils, committees, task
5 forces, and other agencies; to prescribe the powers and duties of
6 governmental entities and officials; to regulate occupations,
7 facilities, and agencies affecting the public health; to regulate
8 health maintenance organizations and certain third party adminis-
9 trators and insurers; to promote the efficient and economical
10 delivery of health care services, to provide for the appropriate
11 utilization of health care facilities and services, and to pro-
12 vide for the closure of hospitals or consolidation of hospitals
13 or services; to provide for the collection and use of data and
14 information; to provide for the transfer of property; to provide
15 certain immunity from liability; to regulate and prohibit the
16 sale and offering for sale of drug paraphernalia under certain
17 circumstances; TO REGULATE ACTIVITIES AFFECTING THE ENVIRONMENT
18 AND PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT; to provide for
19 penalties and remedies; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts;
20 to repeal certain parts of this act; and to repeal certain parts
21 of this act on specific dates.

22 Sec. 1104. (1) "Administrative procedures act of 1969"
23 means Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended, being
24 sections 24.201 to ~~24.315~~ 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
25 or a successor act.

26 (2) "Adult" means an individual 18 years of age or older.

(3) "Code" means the public health code.

(4) "Department", except as provided in article 15, means the ~~state~~ department of ~~public~~ ENVIRONMENT AND HUMAN health.

(5) "Director", except as provided in article 15, means the ~~state~~ director of ~~public~~ ENVIRONMENT AND HUMAN health.

(6) "Governmental entity" means a government, governmental subdivision or agency, or public corporation.

Sec. 2201. The department of ~~public~~ ENVIRONMENT AND HUMAN health and the office of the director of ~~public~~ ENVIRONMENT AND HUMAN health created by sections 425 and 426 of THE EXECUTIVE ORGANIZATION ACT OF 1965, Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being sections 16.525 and 16.526 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, shall continue under this code.

Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 86th Legislature are enacted into law:
