- 5 Sec. 227f. (1) A person who commits or attempts to commit a
- 6 crime that involves a violent act or a threat of a violent act
- 7 against another person while wearing body armor is guilty of a
- 8 felony. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PEACE OFFICER WHILE
- 9 PERFORMING HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A PEACE OFFICER.
